Vernon Electric Cooperative allows members of the Cooperative to sell excess energy from their renewable energy system to the Cooperative at retail rate. There is a one-time equipment charge of \$500 for the installation of a bi-directional meter and a monthly Facility Charge of \$3.00 for the "sell back" portion of the meter. This is in addition to the regular monthly Facility Charge.

Distributed Generation Pre-Interconnection Checklist For Member Use (40 KW system or less)

- Meeting at location with VEC Field Technician to inspect present service equipment
- Application completed and returned to Cooperative
- Interconnection Agreement
 - Signed and returned to Cooperative
 - Cooperative signed and returned to member before inspection and anti-islanding test

NOTE: System shall not be energized to back-feed grid until anti-islanding test is performed by Vernon Electric personnel.

- Certificate of Insurance provided to Cooperative
 - \$300,000 minimum liability (20 KW or less generation capacity)
 - OR**
 - \$1,000,000 minimum liability (20 - 200 KW generation capacity)
- Inverter/Equipment Certification of UL 1741 Compliance documentation submitted
- Equipment Specifications submitted
- Interconnection Line-Diagram submitted

Bi-directional metering:

- \$500 paid for bi-directional metering service
- Wiring affidavit signed by electrician and returned to Cooperative

REBATES: Vernon Electric is offering a rebate for net-metered, new solar photovoltaic installations on Vernon Electric lines of \$250 per KW of installed capacity, up to \$750 maximum. This rebate is evaluated annually (12/31) and could change. To submit for a rebate please supply copies of paid invoices for labor and equipment. Solar panels must have been purchased within 6 months of installation.
