

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- ❖ Maximum rebate is \$1,300. Up to \$300 rebate will be paid toward the initial cost of a home energy audit and 50% up to \$1,000 will be paid toward improvements made based on the auditor's recommendations.
- ❖ Energy Efficiency improvements must be recommendations from an audit arranged by your cooperative or a cooperative approved partner.
- ❖ The audit must be a comprehensive audit including a written report.
- ❖ The audit report must indicate the improvement will result in electrical or delivered fossil fuels (LP, oil) reduction or efficiency.
- ❖ If another rebate is available, the audit recommended improvement will qualify for only that rebate. For example, if an auditor recommends purchasing an Energy Star refrigerator, the refrigerator will qualify for our Appliance rebate, not the Audit Recommended Improvements rebate.
- ❖ Improvements must be completed within 24 months of the audit date.
- ❖ Home or farm being improved must be on cooperative's lines.
- ❖ If member has multiple audits performed in a calendar year, only improvements from one of the audits will qualify for this rebate.
- ❖ Each audit qualifies for only one rebate (additional improvements completed in a later year do not qualify for another rebate).
- ❖ Additional eligibility criteria may apply. Contact cooperative for details.
- ❖ Rebates are in place through December 31, 2017. Funds are limited so members are encouraged to submit as soon as possible.
- ❖ All documentation listed below must be submitted no later than 3 months after improvements are completed.
 - This Rebate Form
 - A copy of your receipt or invoice for each improvement
 - Copy of the audit documentation
 - Documentation showing improvements have been completed
